This one day forum follows the 63rd United Nations Annual Department of Public Information (DPI) / Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) Conference held at the Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre entitled “Advance Global Health: Achieve the MDGs”. The forum also comes just three weeks before the UN General Assembly Summit on the Millennium Development Goals.
