



## Opportunity to Learn about Primary Health Care in Jamkhed, India

**Take the opportunity to study developing world health at a world-renowned centre in rural India, expose yourself to the real issues of global health and learn how communities can be empowered to change....**

The Australian International Health Institute (AIHI) in partnership with the Jamkhed Comprehensive Rural Health Project (CRHP) will be running **two** short courses at the Jamkhed Institute in Maharashtra State of India.

The courses are designed for medical, allied health, social work, nursing, development studies students and anyone who is keen to learn about health in resource poor settings.

Learn about the principles and practice of community-based primary health care at a program that is an international model, from the staff and villagers who pioneered this transforming experience, and transform yourself and your understanding of primary health care.

The course can be taken as short course or for academic credit; it is an elective subject within the University of Melbourne Master of Public Health.

### Course Dates

Two 3-week courses will be offered:

Course 1: 18 November - 8 December 2007

Course 2: 6 - 26 January 2008

**Cost** - AUD 1850, includes tuition, accommodation and meals for the 3 weeks at Jamkhed.\*
